




This document provides all the necessary information to allow your product to be properly and safely installed. Before beginning the installation and operation of your new product, the installation technician and operator must read this manual completely.

Remote Control Instruction Manual

This manual describes how to use the remote search light.

In this manual you will learn about:

- 1. Basic function of the remote control;
- 2. Connect the light to remote control.





Android



Basic functions

Only on condition that the light is connected to remote control, it can be remote controlled.

On: Turn on the light before turning on the remote control, that means the code matching;

Off: Turn off the light;

Up: Head up; Down: Head down; Left : Turn left; Right: Turn right;

Speed: Fast/Slow speed switch;

Flash: Flashing pattern.

Connect the light

Factory setting has been coded.

Disonnect the light

If you find the remote control is not matching the light, please do the following:

- 1. Press the SPEED key and the RESET key at the same time for 5 seconds when power supply connected.(Picture 1) $\,$
- 2. If the light flashes, the coding is successful; otherwise, the coding fails.
- 3. If the coding fails, the power must be turned on again, and repeat above operation.
